SwD Green Slip Policy

SWD is a growing and developing organisation that wishes to retain and build on the respect in which it is held not only the sailing world but with many other groups and organisations that have experienced or are aware of SWD's community service and inclusive approach to people with disabilities. SWD manages to deliver many wonderful opportunities and programs through the support it receives from it's sponsors and the effort and commitment of its volunteers and sailing crew. SWD has developed a policy called the "Green Slip" which is designed to help both current members of SWD and persons interested in becoming members of SWD understand what is required of them in order that they may go sailing with SWD. Each person who wishes to sail with SWD must qualify for a "Green Slip" and that is achieved by each person or member meeting the following criteria:

1. After their third sail with SWD anyone who is not a member and wishes to sail again will need to complete a membership form and submit it to SWD together with the current membership fee.
2. All SWD members are required to promptly reply to all reasonable requests for information from SWD and particularly within any timeframe notified by SWD. SWD understands there may be mitigating circumstances that result in delay in providing information but it remains the member's obligation to provide the information requested as soon as possible.
3. Members sailing with SWD are obliged at all times to:
 - (a) take care of their personal safety
 - (b) act safely and responsibly towards other persons onboard
 - (c) take proper care of all gear and equipment on the boat, and
 - (d) follow all instructions from the skipper or sailing master.
